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Application

High Speed Sortation systems are used when a fairly high flow of cases, parcels or items need to flow to different locations. Locations may be other conveyors, transport routes, or order consolidation assignments.

Requirement

Items are identified prior to reaching the sorting area. A controller alerts a particular sensor and diverting mechanism that an item is approaching. Upon arrival to the sorting area, an optical sensor verifies the position of the item. When the item arrives at the sorting area, a sensor signals the precise time when the diverter needs to be activated. The item is sorted successfully.




