## EU REACH (SVHC 197) Statement

This statement concerns European Union regulation 1907/2006 of 18 December 2006 -- Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals, also known as REACH.

Under REACH regulations we are considered a provider of "articles." All of our products are assemblies, not raw materials. None of our products intentionally releases substances to the environment. We have completed the process of contacting our suppliers of "substances, preparations, and articles" to ensure that all necessary pre-registration/registration requirements are being met within the required timeframes.

We claim no exposure of this material to humans or the environment during normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use including disposal. The sum of each unique construction material in our articles imported into E.U. is also less than one tonne per year.

Given those conditions our products are exempted from REACH pre-registration and later registration activities. Our exempt status is based on our understanding of REACH, the SVHC-197 lists published on 15 January 2019, and our knowledge of materials list.
